## MODERNITY AND ATEMPORALITY: HISTORICAL vs. ECONOMIC TIME

**Abstract:** Time – as an element of universality – belongs to knowledge as well as to reality. That is why it becomes multiple and reversible, its allocation being an essential issue from the social-economic point of view.
