IS THERE AN ENTREPRENEURIAL CULTURE IN THE ROMANIAN PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES?

Abstract: The paper presents the results of a research performed in May and June 2009 concerning the degree of acceptance of the concept of entrepreneurial culture by the academic staff from several Romanian public universities. This article represents a continuation of the study “*Is there an entrepreneurial spirit in the Romanian public universities?*”

The research is restrained as long as it covers only a part of the public universities and does not consider the private universities. In spite of this, the results presented as follows allow us to affirm that the entrepreneurial spirit is manifest in some of the Romanian public universities, according to the economic environment dynamics, in the context that, at a European level, the support of the superior education is in a limited way sustained by the State.

Data interpretation revealed a high degree of acceptance of the concept of entrepreneurial culture and the tendency to associate it with its positive apprehension.
