Abstract: The justice reform has characterized the recent decades through a constant concern for meeting the obligations of membership of the European Union, harmonization of legislation and identification of appropriate qualitative benchmarks for the current requirements. So, the notions of quality, quality management, quality assessment, required a multidimensional analysis, including mainstreaming the national perspective into the European efforts for quality of justice. In this context, the study aims to investigate to what extent the Romanian judicial system can take examples of good practice in the field, like the pattern of a Northern country as the Netherlands, in the context of cultural differences. The article insists on understanding the concept of culture, cultural differences and their implications on judicial management. Appealing to Geert Hofstede's research and using the case study method, the paper aims to emphasize and underling the cultural differences between these systems, understand how cultural dimensions can influence judicial management and propose appropriate solutions.
